

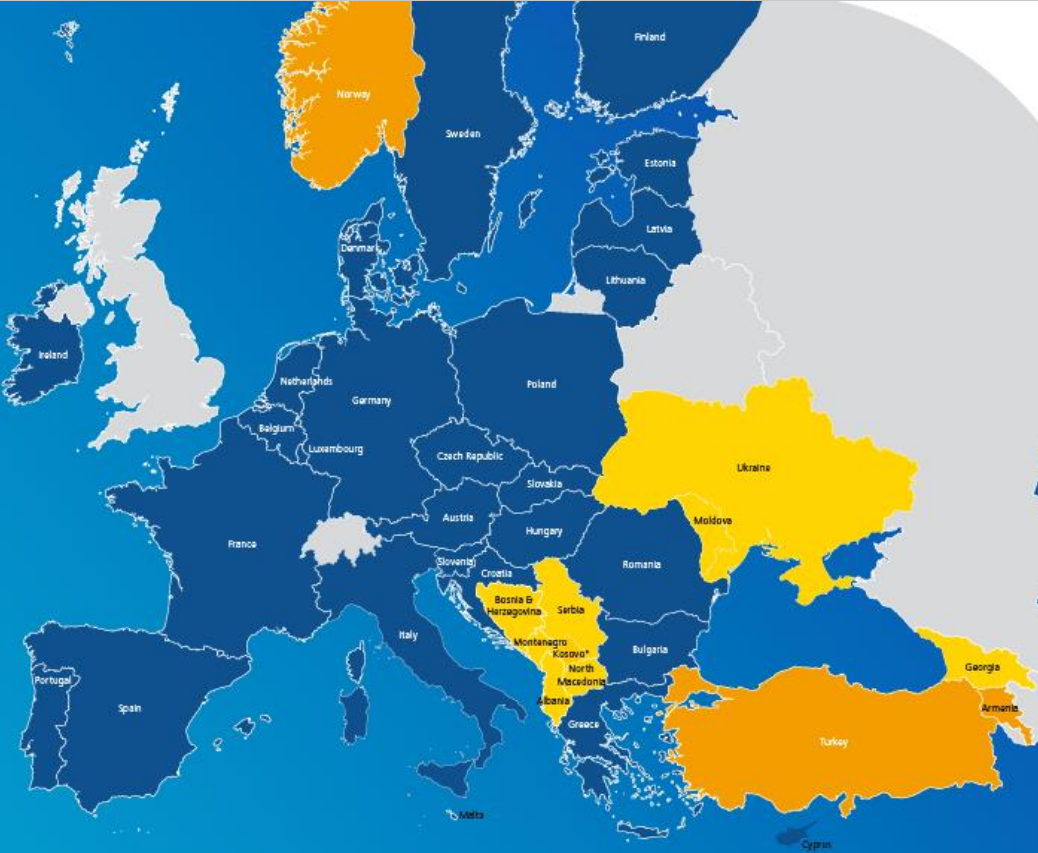

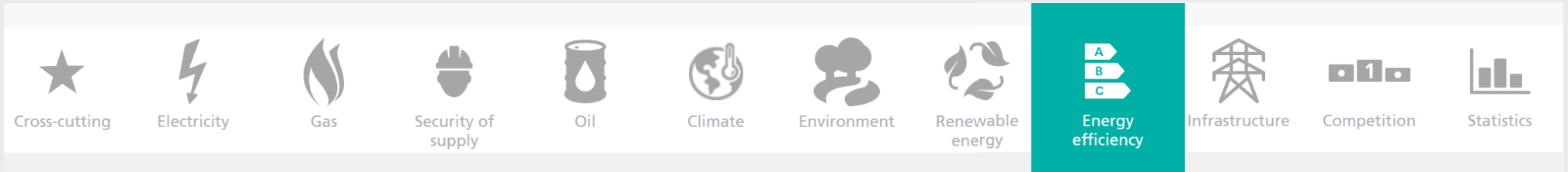

To stay on track with the evolution of European Union law, the Treaty allows the adaptation of the acquis and implementing of possible amendments.

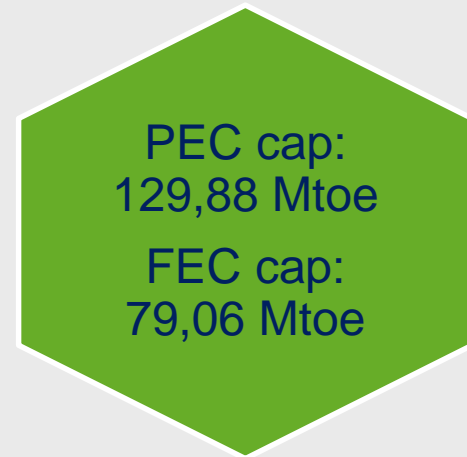
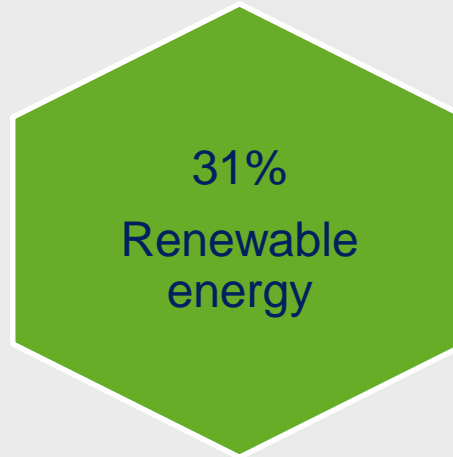
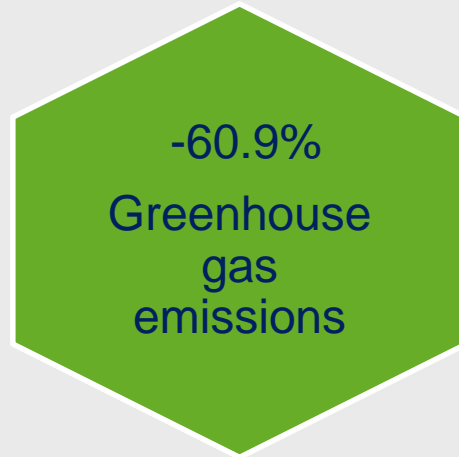
This ensures that the **Contracting Parties keep pace with EU developments** and continuously align their regulatory frameworks in the energy and related sectors to those of the EU.

CLEAN ENERGY PACKAGE – ACQUIS RELATED TO ENERGY EFFICIENCY



❖ **Revised Energy Efficiency Directive:**

- ✓ It updates a common framework of energy efficiency policy measures within the Energy Community, to meet 2030 energy efficiency targets.
- ✓ Energy efficiency obligation scheme: energy savings obligations extended for the next period 2024-2030 (new savings of 0.8% each year).
- ✓ Stronger exemplary role of the public sector:
(annual buildings renovation target: until 2023 - 1%; from 2024 onwards – 3%).
- ✓ Strengthened rules on individual metering and billing of thermal energy (better information for consumers).
- ✓ Integration of EE in energy and climate policies (e.g. NECP and national EE contributions) and promotion of EE 1st principle.

❖ **Revised Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (partly) :**

- ✓ Slightly revised by the Governance Regulation.
- ✓ New Article 2a added: Long-term building renovation strategy.
- ✓ Full revision of EPBD will be proposed to the Ministerial Council in 2024.

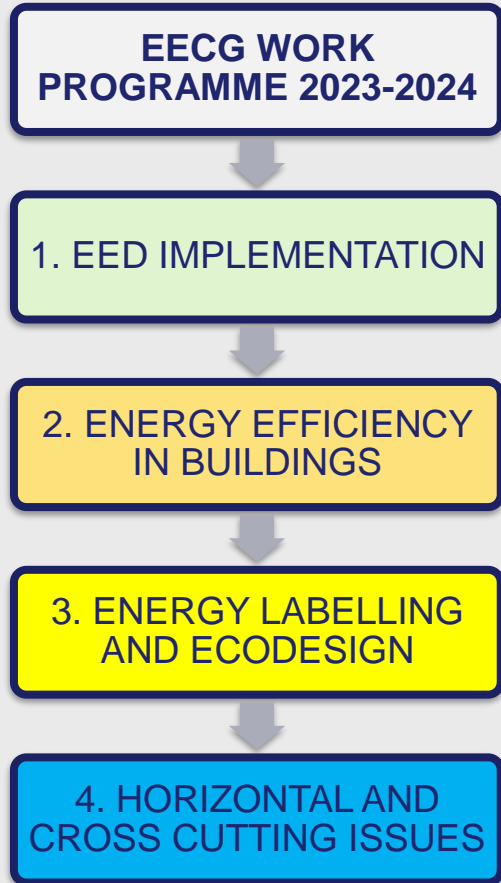
❖ Regulation on energy statistics (energy balances under EUROSTAT):

- ✓ same obligations and deadline as for EU MS.
- ✓ only industrial breakdown missing to date, but will start to be provided from next year onwards.

❖ Governance Regulation:

- ✓ Art. 3: draft NECPs to be submitted by 30 June 2023, final NECPs to be submitted by 30 June 2024.
- ✓ Art. 17: integrated national energy and climate progress reports due by 15-Mar-2025 and every two years after (incl. quantification of the impact of policies and measures)
- ✓ Art. 21: Integrated reporting on energy efficiency
- ✓ Please note that Contracting Parties will report to the Secretariat and also to the European Environmental Agency (EEA); the latter is also being engaged in the reporting of EU MS.

- ✚ Active since 2013 - to **foster EE cooperation!**
- ✚ **Key objective:** to facilitate the transposition of Energy Efficiency Directives into national legislation and support effective implementation:
>> Directive 2012/27/EU (EED), Directive 2010/31/EU (EPBD), Energy labelling
- ✚ **EECG includes** all Contracting Parties, EU COM (DG ENER, DG NEAR), ECS, Donors/IFIs
- ✚ **Initiator, coordinator, and implementation partner** of various assistance projects
- ✚ **New EECG work programme 2023-2024**
- ✚ **EECG meetings:** 3 per year, combined with workshops




ENERGY EFFICIENCY EECG WORK PROGRAMME 2023-2024

✚ FOCUSES ON **COMMON IMPLEMENTATION CHALLENGES** AND NEW DEVELOPMENTS:

Clean Energy Package (EED/Governance), new 2030 targets and integrated planning/reporting, EPBD recast, new labelling & ecodesign regulation, new developments in EU etc.

✚ **SYNERGIES WITH ODYSSEE-MURE PROJECT:**

- Monitoring and reporting on 2030 energy and climate targets
- Development of EE Indicators
- Joint activities (WSs)

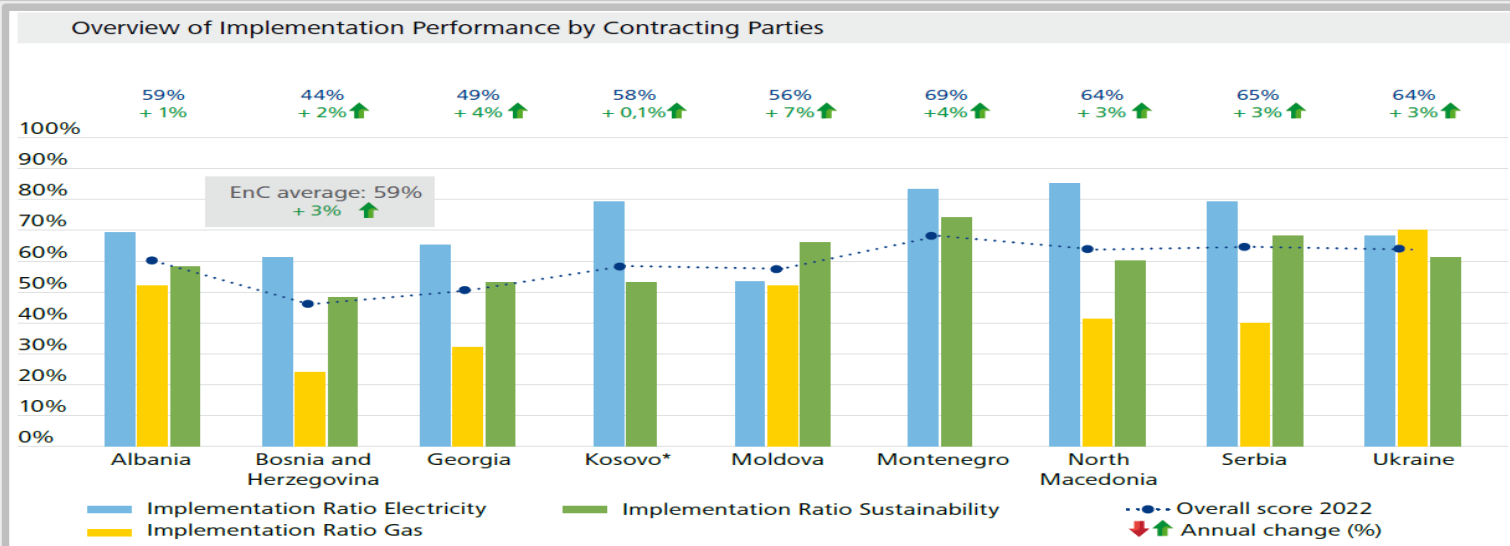
